Administrative History

The St. Mary's University Athletic Department hired Bill Rives as Publicity Manager from 1930-1931 to promote the football program. This resulted in the accumulation of news clippings in scrapbooks. During his presidency, Walter Buehler (1950-1961) established an "Office of Civic [Public] Relations." Public Relations Directors for that period were: Mr. Jack Mullen (1954), Brother Daniel J. Rabitt, SM (1956); Mr. Leo A. Yetman (1958), Charles O. Brown (1960). In 1958, because of a lack of space in the Administration Building (St. Louis Hall), the Public Relations office was moved to the downtown campus.

During the presidency of Father Louis Blume (1963-1973), Charles W. Kenworthey was hired as director of public relations beginning February 1, 1967. In 1967, a "Communications Committee" functioned as a subsidiary of the development program called "Education 6000." The goal of "Education 6000" was to grow enrollment to 6000 students in ten years (1965-1975) and to enlarge campus facilities sufficiently to service the added enrollment. The Communications Committee had about 38 members including the university president and the deans of the schools, businessmen from San Antonio, and the following administrators: Jack C. Hollimon, director of special resources; Charles W. Kenworthey, director of public relations; Al Notzon, director of alumni relations; and John Michel, associate director of admissions. Mr.

Kenworthey asked the committee for assistance in devising "a public relations guideline for St. Mary's that would serve as baseboard statement of concepts and goals" to replace the former practice of "publicizing by guesswork and treating each PR opportunity as an isolated fragment unrelated to a total picture." Thus began the notion of a coherent University "branding" and "marketing effort.

The branding and marketing functions have caused the public relations function to be closely associated administratively with development, student recruitment, and alumni relations. In 2002, the Public Relations Office was officially designated "Office of University Communications" to reflect an expanded mission scope" to unite the University's marketing efforts...to deliver a clear, consistent and compelling message about St. Mary's University." In 2007, the scope of the Office of University Communications was extended to include world wide web coordination and development.

Messer, Jr, assistant director of public relations for news and information (1990); Elizabeth Chamberlain, news and information officer (1993); Elizabeth Barbee, communications coordinator for the School of Law (2007); Bart Clarkson, web coordinator (2007); Jake Salazar, director of web development (2007); Nina Duran, publications coordinator (2007).

The Communications/Public Relations Office in the early days reported to the president and then since the 1960s to a vice president for university advancement/development.

Collection Overview

Public relations at St. Mary's University was mostly *ad hoc* before 1967 consisting of periodic announcements for student recruitment and promotion of sporting events. Each effort was undertaken without reference to an overall plan. Consequently, most of the materials before 1967 consist of scrapbooks with news clippings of advisements or of reporting by the local press mainly of interscholastic sports. The first effort at a sustained publicity program begins during the 1950s. A permanent office with professional employees began to operate. In 1967, the president Reverend Louis Blume formed a Communications Committee and hired a director of public relations. After 1967 the University began a systematic program of conscious image projection in the service of advancement/development that grew size and responsibility as reflected in the office files to the point where all campus publications and public outreach efforts required approval by the communications/public relations office. The records after 1967 grow in complexity and diversity. By the 1990s, the office maintained drop files on all campus personnel and the main campus activities to provide its staff with research capability.

Processing Note: From the *Annual Report* for 1997-1998 by Brother Robert Wood, SM: "Another large project was reorganizing and photocopying all of the News Clippings from 1978 to 1982. These had been put into binders in helter-skelter order so that it wasn't possible to find any given day or month easily. Now all of these clippings are in chronological order (and the recopying saved a lot of space and paper). This took close to three months to complete."

Series 5: Campus Clippings, 1980-1998

Content Note: *Campus Clippings* is the title of an informal campus publication. The following statement appears on its cover: "*Campus Clippings* is produced periodically by the Public Relations Department as a representative sampling of news items about St. Mary's University that appear in the press." *Campus Clippings* appeared in serially numbered issues from 1 to 18 (1980-1988). Then it grew greatly in number of pages and was designated by date only without issue numbering. Finally, the product was much reduced in size and retitled, "*St. Mary's University News Highlights*: A synopsis of local, regional and national media coverage," from May 1987 to fall 1988.
