PURPOSE AND SCOPE:

SAAAACF will operate and manage the fund to support the following charitable causes:

- Relief of the poor, the distressed, or the underprivileged
- Eliminating prejudice and discrimination
- Defending human and civil rights secured by law
- Combating community deterioration and juvenile delinquency

ALLOCATION:

The Fund will provide resources to address:

- **BAIL ISSUES**
 - Increase availability of bail and release persons from confinement who otherwise would be unable to afford bail and would suffer from the adverse effects associated with confinement
- POLICE EXCESSIVE FORCE ISSUES

 Legal/financial aid to individuals who have experienced excessive force and other abuses of power by law enforcement
- RACIAL DISCRIMINATION ISSUES

 (in employment, housing or public accommodations)

 Aid in pursuit of claims; legal challenges to policies or practices
- VOTING RIGHTS

 Aid in pursuit of claims regarding voter suppression and intimidation based on race
