BAIL ISSUES

Increase availability of bail and release persons from confinement who otherwise would be unable to afford bail and would suffer from the adverse effects associated with confinement



POLICE EXCESSIVE FORCE ISSUES

Legal/financial aid to individuals who have experienced excessive force and other abuses of power by law enforcement



RACIAL DISCRIMINATION ISSUES

(in employment, housing or public accommodations)

Aid in pursuit of claims; legal challenges to policies or practices



VOTING RIGHTS

Aid in pursuit of claims regarding voter suppression and intimidation based on race
